

The Neurological hospitals of the University Medical Center Mainz and the Goethe University Frankfurt organized for the third time the rmn2 Spring School in Neurology.

From April 23-27, 2018, both departments offered a broad spectrum of seminars and practical training to convey the fascination that renders this increasingly important clinical discipline attractive for students, young clinicians and scientists. The school not only taught tricks for clinical work, but also presented translational research approaches and reflected on ethical aspects.

20 participants from all over Germany and Italy, who were primarily at the end of their student training, were accommodated in the youth hostels in Mainz and Frankfurt, if required. Participation was free for final year medical students from both departments. As in previous years, the event was sponsoring-free, as both department directors were kind enough to contribute funds to cover the difference between costs and participation fees. The students felt comfortable and learned a lot. A young clinician had expected a clinical training course and had therefore a slightly different expectation than the other participants. We will therefore define the target group more clearly in the call for participants in future.
